Roy G. DeLong Scholarship Program

Coffey Health Foundation established The Roy G. DeLong scholarship program to encourage young adults to pursue a college education.

Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 are given annually to select students from area high schools. High school seniors in Coffey and Woodson Counties (Southern Coffey County, Lebo, Waverly, and Yates Center) may apply for this scholarship.

Requirements

Consideration is based on the following factors:

- attendance at the respective high school both the junior and senior year,
- minimum grade point average of 3.0,
- completion of all requirements for graduation, and
- submission of a completed application accompanied by an essay, official ACT/SAT scores, high school transcript, and senior photo by the April 15, 2026 deadline.

The Foundation executive committee evaluates applications and determines scholarship recipients. If necessary, personal interviews are scheduled.

Renewal

Based upon availability of funds, scholarships are renewable annually for up to four years and are distributed at a rate of \$500 per semester (\$1000 per year).

Each semester, students must provide the Foundation with proof of enrollment in at least 12 semester hours and an official transcript confirming a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
