Adult Scholarship Program

The Coffey Health Foundation established its scholarship program to encourage young adults to pursue a college education in fields related to healthcare.

One \$1,000 scholarship is given to a student currently enrolled in an accredited university or college program with a declared healthcare major.

Requirements

Consideration is based on the following factors:

- minimum grade point average of 3.0,
- classification as a college junior,
- completion of all requirements for acceptance into a health-related **field of study**,
- **confirmation that student is enrolled in 12 semester hours**,
- submission of a completed application accompanied by official college transcripts by the April 15, 2025 deadline, and
- **possible participation in a personal interview with the Foundation board.**

The Foundation executive committee evaluates applications and determines scholarship recipients.

Renewal

Based upon availability of funds, scholarships are renewable for a second year and are distributed at a rate of \$500 per semester (\$1000 per year).

Students must provide the Foundation with proof of enrollment in at least 12 semester hours and an official transcript confirming a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
